Pasco North Stake YW Camp Rules

- 1. Reach out and be a friend. Come to have a great time! Have a good attitude!
- 2. Never leave fires unattended. See that they are completely out before leaving your camp for any meeting or activity.
- 3. Electronics: "Be careful that your use of technology and media does not replace spending in-person time with... friends.... Take a break from the virtual world, and connect with people in real life." (FSY Booklet) Electronics may be used for scripture study and picture taking at camp. (Note: Cellphone service and access to charge phones is extremely limited.)
- 4. Shoes must be worn at all times. No bare feet. Flip flops may be worn in showers only. All footwear should be secure for uneven terrain.
- 5. Shorts and sandals are not recommended due to climate, ticks, and terrain.
- 6. Please be modest in your clothing and swimwear. "Avoid styles that emphasize or draw inappropriate attention to your physical body instead of who you are as a child of God with an eternal future." (FSY booklet)
- 7. Everyone has camp duties. Do your part.
- 8. Respect others property. Never get in to someone else's belongings without permission.
- 9. NO PRANKS! Do not do anything that will cause damage to personal property or someone's self esteem. We want young women camp to be a safe place for everyone.
- 10. Everyone must be in camp boundaries at all times. Adults should know where each young woman in their unit is.
- 11. Sleep in your own tent and stay there after Tent Check
- 12. Attend all our activities and classes. Be where you're supposed to be.
- 13. Use the buddy system. Don't go anywhere alone. Even adults.
- 14. While we encourage bonding and friendships at camp with peers, it is not the setting for developing physical relationships.
- 15. Young women will be sent home for inappropriate behavior. Parents will be required to pick up their daughter in that case.
